Cirro stratus clouds

Very high up in the sky, can give a hazy look to the sun, that's because this cloud is made up of tiny ice crystals.



Cumulonimbus

A big cloud that towers up into the sky, it usually looks very grey....time to get your umbrella! Watch out as they might be accompanied by a thunderstorm!



Mackerel Sky

This is made up of rows of cirrocumulus or altocumulus and the pattern resembles fish scales! It could mean that rain is on it's way so get ready to pack away your picnic

A lower level fluffy cloud, everyone likes to see this one as it occurs in good weather. The bottom of these clouds are often flat.
