Fostering peace, reflection and deep connection to nature.





- 99 council managed allotment plots
- 5 grass football pitches
- 3 multi-use games areas
- 14 playgrounds
- 1 skate park
- 1 Golf Course (18 hole)
- 2 beaches
- 3 bowling greens
- 1 plant nursery
- 400,000 trees
- 2 cemeteries and 1 crematorium
