





# Association AL LARK

Value enhancement on the intrinsic link between these domains through citizen science






- Only 8 answered the form and signed a MoU




## First feedbacks

- Type of data needed :
  - Additional Photo-ID Catalogs
  - Comparison with other Photo-ID catalogs
  - Access to larger population estimates
  - Habitat and environmental data
- Expectations regarding collaboration :
  - Open to share data with a signed agreement
  - Joint authorship
  - Long-term partnerships
  - Data privacy

# Step 4: First results from collaboration

## photo-id analysis

4 sites :

Two in the north :

- **IM-UK** Isle of Man, MMDW
- **C-UK** Cornwall, Marine Discovery

Two in the south :

- **NWFB** North-West French Brittany, PNM
- **NEFB** North-East French Brittany, AL LARK

Data were collected over 17 years (2007-2024)

## Connectivity



Fig 3. Individuals seen at NEFB-NWFB

- 4 individuals seen at both French sites (**NEFB** ↔ **NWFB**)
- NEFB: No matches with UK sites (**IM-UK** or **C-UK**) to date

→ Indicates regional structuring and limited trans-Channel exchange




Fig 1. Sampling sites

# Step 4: First results from collaboration

## CURRENT PERSPECTIVES :

- Add environmental covariates (bathymetry, temperature, prey availability) to deeper analysis
- Trophic markers & Isotopic ecology : What do coastal Risso's eat?
- Does coastal fidelity reflect feeding, calving or migratory stopover?






Suite à la signature de la convention de partenariat avec l'OFB, le projet Rissot fait peau neuve et arbore un nouveau nom : **EDRIM** i.e Etude des Dauphins de Rissot de la Manche.

Lancé en 2024, **EDRIM** a pour but d'apporter de nouvelles connaissances sur le Dauphin de Rissot. Ce mammifère marin océanique, classé comme "Vulnérable" en Normandie et "Data Deficient" en Bretagne, présente une utilisation saisonnière des zones côtières, notamment sur le littoral breton et la façade métropolitaine Atlantique.
