



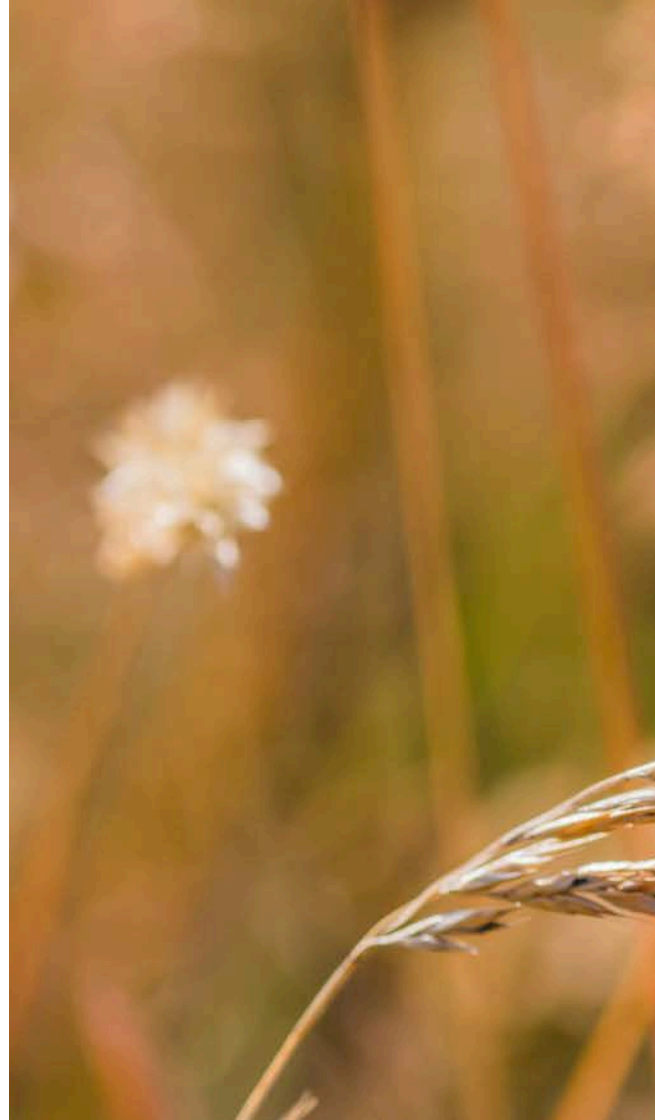

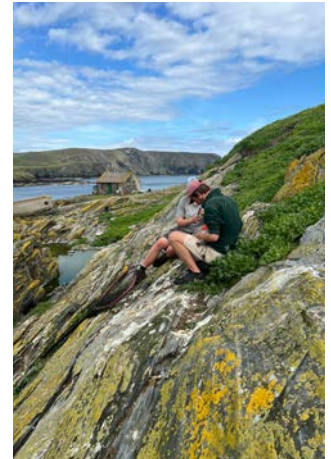


Partnering with MWT offers a range of benefits to help your organisation support a wilder Isle of Man.
