### WILDLIFE ACT 1990

#### THE CRONK Y BING AYRES NATIONAL NATURE RESERVE DECLARATION 2026

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture by section 31(1), and with the concurrence of Treasury, as required by section 37(3) of the Wildlife Act 1990, the following declaration is hereby made:-

#### Citation

1. This declaration may be cited as The Cronk y Bing Ayres National Nature Reserve Declaration 2026.

#### Commencement

2. This Declaration comes into operation on 14 July 2026.

#### Interpretation

3. In this declaration "the Reserve" means the land at Cronk y Bing in the Parish of Andreas delineated by a thick black line on the attached plan.

#### Declaration

4. The Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture, being satisfied that the Reserve –  
(a) is being managed as a nature reserve by the owner or occupier; and  
(b) is a nature reserve of national importance for its flora, fauna, or geological or physiographic features,

hereby declares that land to be a National Nature Reserve.
